Sub:- Revised Work Load for College Teachers.

C I R C U L A R

The U.G.C. guidelines stipulates 180 working/teaching days in all the Colleges. However, in J&K State there are hardly 140 days of teaching in a year resulting in loss of teaching to students. U.G.C. has also stipulated one hour per day for research work in the Colleges whereas hardly any research work is presently being carried out in the Colleges. In order to compensate the loss of teaching days, it has been decided that henceforth a College Teacher should at least provide six lectures of 40 minutes duration per day in the Colleges and the rest two hours in the College can be utilized as break in between the lecturers or for other allied works of the College.

It has also been decided that in future class strength of 80 students for theory and the practice group of 30 students be adopted. Any extra class should not be less than 50 students in strength and in case of lesser number of students, they should be distributed evenly amongst other classes.

The Principals of the Colleges are accordingly impressed upon to follow strictly the above guidelines while preparing the time table for College Teachers. Any deviation of the instructions shall be viewed seriously by the authorities and action, if any, required shall be initiated against the erring officer.
