Subjects – Recognition thereof.


I am directed to invite the attention of the Principal Secretary/
Commissioner/Secretary to Government General Adm. Deptt. to
the subject noted above and to enclose herewith the following :-

- i) The decision of the Jammu University and Kashmir University with regard to the recognition of Distance Mode degrees.
- ii) Distance Education Council / UGC guidelines regarding Distance Education.
- iii) Copy of Judgment delivered by the Hon' ble Supreme Court of India in Professor Yashpal V/s State of Chhattisgarh.
- iv) A list of 44 Deemed Universities de-recognized by Ministry of Human Resource and Development (MHRD).

The Jammu University and Kashmir University do not recognize distance mode degrees in Science subjects, which decision of theirs is in accordance with the DEC/UGC guidelines and the Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Further, any degree awarded by the de-recognized Deemed Universities in Distance Mode also has to be dealt with accordingly. However, campus mode degrees awarded before the de-recognition of these Deemed Universities shall be referred to Jammu University and Kashmir University for determining their recognition status.
