Subject: Establishment of Private Engineering Colleges in the State.

Memo,

I am to forward herewith the decision of the Cabinet on the above subject as quoted below. Copies of the Government Orders Instructions, if any issued in this behalf may be sent to the General Administration Department for record.

The Cabinet approved the No Objection Certificates in favour of Model Institute of Engineering and Technology Jammu, S.S.M. College of Engineering Srinagar and Mahant Bachitar Singh College of Engineering, Jammu. All the three institutions shall obtain necessary approval and respective university affiliations before admissions are made.

Applications of other proposed private engineering colleges were not approved and no further request for setting up of engineering colleges shall be entertained unless detailed assessment is made in respect of manpower requirements in the concerned field. This assessment shall be done by the Planning Department. →

The grant of No Objection Certificate to the setting up of above three private engineering colleges will be subject to the condition that they will admit, both in free and payment categories

50% candidates each from amongst the permanent residents of the State and from outside the State. However, if there is a short-fall in either category in a particular year, the seats will be filled up from the other category (from permanent residents or from outside the State).”
